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Notes to Administrative Rules Spreadsheet

¹ “MARS” refers to the Model Administrative Rules promulgated by the International Association of Commercial Administrators (“IACA”) to implement UCC Article 9. “Hybrid” refers to rules that incorporate elements of MARS, but contain significant deviations. “Other” refers to rules that do not appear to be based on MARS. “NA” means the state has not adopted administrative rules for the UCC.

² California adopted rules that reflect an abbreviated version of MARS.

³ The filing office adopted rules that appear to directly contradict one or more statutory requirements of Article 9 as enacted by the state.

⁴ Hawaii adopted a one-paragraph rule that simply provides that UCC records are recordable documents.

⁵ The Louisiana Secretary of State, which maintains the UCC Information Management System used by the parishes, links to a 2010 draft of the IACA MARS. It appears intended to provide general guidance rather than to reflect formal adoption of the rules.

⁶ The New Hampshire Secretary of State has not formally adopted UCC Rules. The filing office UCC web page has a link to the current MARS page on the IACA website.

⁷ The UCC filing office does not link to the administrative rules, but the rules are available through a separate secretary of state web page.

⁸ The Department of State’s 2018 biannual report to the legislature on compliance with Article 9 indicates that the department has proposed UCC administrative rules for adoption in 2019.

⁹ The Wyoming Secretary of State adopted a minimal set of rules for UCC Article 9 in June 2013 and updated them in 2018. The rules recognize use of the UCC5 Information Statement, but otherwise do not address the terminology or form changes contained in the 2010 Amendments.
